## Glenn Flint Waterfowl Hunting Blind Selection Procedure - 2018-19 Season

- 1. Obtain your Launch Permit To obtain your 2018-19 Boat Launch Permit follow these steps:
  - Launch Permits become available at the pay station on October 16<sup>th</sup>. The pay station is located at the Glenn Flint launch ramp. The cost of Annual Permits is now \$50. The pay station is available 24/7.
  - When viewing the screen at the pay station Follow these steps:
    - The first screen says "Welcome to Glenn Flint Lake". "Press D to continue" Choose D
    - Choose "Launch Permit" next
    - o Then choose "Buy Annual Permit"
    - o The next screen will state "\$50 To Park Until 12:00 AM..... Please Insert Card" At this time you will insert credit card for payment. The station accepts Visa, Master Card, Discover, and Debit Cards.
    - After Credit Card approval, the pay station will issue the Annual Launch Permit to you.

## Annual Launch Permits for the 2018-19 season become available beginning Oct 16<sup>th</sup>.

- Use your 2018-19 Launch Permit number to complete the Waterfowl Draw Application.
- 2. **Complete the Application for Drawing for Permits.** Applications are available through hunt coordinator via email.
  - a. Application must include:
  - b. Indiana Hunting License #
  - c. Hip#
  - d. 2018-2019 Launching Permit #
  - e. State Boat Registration #
  - f. Name, Address, Phone, and E-Mail
  - g. Signature and date
  - h. Blind Ranking
- 3. Scan and Email the signed Application to the Hunt Coordinator listed at the bottom of the Application. (Applications only accepted via email)
  - You will receive an email confirming that your application has been received.
  - Deadline for applications to be received is Thursday, November 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Incomplete Applications and Applications received after the deadline will not be eligible for the draw. No
  exceptions.
- Drawing to be held on date and time listed on the "Rules and Regulations Governing the Hunting of Waterfowl on Glenn Flint Lake". Applicants need not be present.
- All Applicants will be notified by email of their blind # or status of "alternate".
- A Waterfowl Hunting Permit (which must remain in the possession of the permittee while hunting at the lake) will be mailed.
- A Blind Card (which must be used to indicate your occupancy of a blind by hanging your card on blind # in the Blind Box located under the shelter next to the boat ramp.) will be mailed.
- Know and Respect the Rules and Regulations Governing the Hunting of Waterfowl on Glenn Flint Lake.
