PC invasive plant removal group spoke to the board about invasive plants they have seen on OWL Trail. Mike motioned to free assessment done. Zach Cox seconded. Vote unanimous.

Mike asked if we had an umbrella policy that would cover it. Something to look into.

The board made a motion to ban wake surfing from Glenn Flint. Steve Stamper approved, and Mike seconded. Vote unanimous. Steve Stamper is either going to make a new sign or add to the existing sign that it is banned.

Steve Stamper is going to put together a new estimate for a new fence line at the entrance of OWL Trail. Zach is going to check with REMC about maybe getting some old phone poles to use.
